Haggai 1

What can we learn from Haggai 1 about prioritizing God's vision for our lives?

Things That Distort God's Vision for our Lives (Haggai 1:2-11)

- Procrastination with what God wants us to do.
- <u>Misguided</u> busyness.
- Failing to recognize when God is working against us.

Ways we embrace God's Vision for our Lives (Haggai 1:12-15)

- Obeying what we know God wants us to do.
- Developing a daily <u>reverence</u> for God.
- Developing an ongoing <u>awareness</u> of God's <u>presence</u>.
- Remembering God wants us to serve Him together.
