2. **READ Mark 1:1-45.** Why do you suppose Jesus started His public ministry in a synagogue? What two things amazed the people about Jesus? Why?

3. How does Jesus' healing (vs. 30-31) compare with His exorcism (v. 25)? What new realm of authority is seen here?

4. After a day like this (vs. 29-34) what pressures could Jesus feel as a new day dawns? What might He pray about (vs. 35)? How might this relate to His decision to move on (vs. 38)?

5. Why is the leper unsure about Jesus' desire to help (see Leviticus 13)? What is significant about Jesus touching the leper prior to healing Him?

6. Where do you need a special touch from Jesus this week? How can you "touch lepers" in your community?
