Samson's life was full of <u>advantages</u> & <u>opportunities</u>. (Judges 13-14)

Samson's legacy is full of honor & shame. (Judges 15-16)

We all have weaknesses & "blind spots". Samson's were lust & pride.

Lust & Pride...

- Can lead us to make some really stupid decisions. (Judges 16:7-17)
- Will eventually make us pay a <u>heavy price</u>. (Judges 16:18-21)
- <u>Hurt</u> other people. (Judges 15:1-10)
- <u>Hinder</u> God's <u>work</u> & <u>power</u> in our lives.

4. **READ Judges 16.** What was Samson's downfall? What was the most redeeming thing about Samson's life?

5. What is one of your greatest strengths that God can use? How can that strength become a weakness? How can you keep it from being your downfall?
