Judges 6:7-24

We can face our fears and overcome them because....

- I. God is <u>aware</u> of every good and bad <u>circumstance</u> that goes on in our life.
  - Sometimes fear comes as a result of our <u>disobedience</u>.
    V.1
    - o Israelites did evil in the sight of God.
  - Sometimes fear comes as a result of <u>turning away</u> from God. V.7-10
    - They worshipped other gods despite being told not to do so.

We can face our fears and overcome them because....

- II. God <u>reminds</u> us He is with us all the time and won't <u>leave</u> us. V.11-16
  - Don't ever <u>forget</u> who is always on your <u>side</u>.
  - Jesus <u>affirms</u> this very statement of being with us.
  - We are all <u>significant</u> in the eyes of the Lord.

- He called Gideon a mighty warrior.
- We are also called <u>conquerors</u> in Christ.

We can face our fears and overcome them because....

## III. God will always be <u>faithful</u> in fulfilling His promises to all who <u>believe</u>. V.17-24

- Don't doubt what God says He can do in and through you.
- God is <u>patient</u> and understands how we <u>are</u> at times.
  V.17-19
- We will see God do amazing things when we follow His instructions. V.20-22
- A life of <u>trusting</u> God leads to a life of perpetual <u>peace</u>.
  V.23-24
