Lesson Aim: To understand how we can love our global Muslim neighbors in partnership with our missionaries, Dave and Pam Wilson.

Prayer: Open in prayer asking the Holy Spirit to show you how to grow in missional living.

Ice Breaker- What is one of the favorite places that you have traveled to? Why?

1. What inspired you about Dave and Pam Wilson and their ministry outreach story?
2. As you reflect on this month of Missional Living, what are the three top things that you learned about living on mission globally and our ministry partners?
3. How do you feel that your vision of who your “neighbors” are has changed during this month?
4. **Read Philemon 6.** How does sharing your faith increase your own understanding and relationship with Christ?

5. A lot of people are hesitant to share their faith because “they don’t know what to say.” How can we become better prepared at sharing our faith with our “neighbors”?
6. **Read Matthew 19:16-30.** Why do you think that the young ruler rejected Jesus and His message of salvation?
7. Fear of rejection is also a top reason that people hesitate to share their faith with their “neighbors.” We see that even Jesus was rejected. How can we overcome the fear of rejection? Are people rejecting us or Jesus?
8. **Luke 12:11-12** shows us that the Holy Spirit will help to give us the words needed when we endeavor to speak out for Christ to others. How does this scripture provide you comfort and confidence? How can we do our part to be ready?

Spend time in prayer that the rest of this year would continue to be a time of courage and growth in missional living outreach. Pray that God would lead you in how to give your time and resources to Living on Mission.

Memorizing Scripture is a key tool to resist temptation, make wise decisions, strengthen us under stress, comfort us when we’re sad and to witness to those who don’t know Christ.
