1. Read Acts 3:1-10. What was the beggar's response to Peter instructing him to "Walk"? How is this an example of how we are to respond to Godly instruction?

2. How is Jesus healing some crippled area of your life? What is an area that needs healing?

**3.** Read Acts 3:11-23. When is it proper to come against a person's sin like Peter did in verses 13-15?

4. Of all the truths about Jesus which Peter emphasizes here, which one strikes you the hardest? Why?

 How has repentance and turning to God brought "times of refreshing" (v. 19) to you? How can that be used as a means of encouraging others to come to Christ?

Weekly Memory Verse:

Deuteronomy 6:6-7. These commandments that I give you today are to be on your hearts. Impress them on your children. Talk about them when you sit at home and when you walk along the road, when you lie down, and when you get up.
