Lesson Aim: To guard our heart and focus on developing a heart that cultivates vision based on God and His Word.

Prayer: Start your time together by asking the Holy Spirit to lead your discussion.

- 1. **Read Ephesians 1:15-23.** What does this passage teach us about Jesus? What does it teach us about discovering vision for our lives?
- 2. In his message Sunday, Scott talked about discovering and pursuing God's vision and goals for our church. What are some areas in your life personally where you hope to discover God's vision?
- 3. What are some principles from this passage that you can apply to your own life that can help you pursue Christ's vision for you?
- 4. READ 1 Samuel 7:10-12. Looking back on 2011, what are one or more "Ebenezers" you are excited about and want to remember that happened through The Bridge? Why?
- 5. Looking back on your own personal life, what are one or more "Ebenezers" that you want to remember from 2011? Why?
- 6. Looking ahead to 2012, do you have room for God to do some new things in your life in the areas of connecting, growing, serving or reaching?
- 7. What are some specific plans you can make to ensure you will pursue this path of growth?
- 8. How can your LifeGroup help you in this process?



Close in prayer by asking God for His vision for yourself, family, friends and The Bridge and however else the Lord leads you.
