## Characteristics of the called:

How are we to <u>understand</u> & <u>embrace</u> what God is calling us to?

- <u>Relationships</u> (Mark 12:28b-31)
- <u>Character</u>-development (Romans 8:29; Galatians 5:22-23; I Corinthians 13:4-7)
- <u>Serving others</u> (Ephesians 2:10)

What do we need to do to live out God's calling in our lives?

- Let the <u>substance</u> of our "yes" determine our <u>power</u> to say "no".
- <u>Identify</u> what helps us say yes to God's calling in our lives & also what <u>takes</u> us away from His calling in our lives.
- <u>Prioritize</u> & <u>plan</u> our lives around our "yes" and experience the freedom to say "no".



**Driven vs. Called (The Power of "No")** Josh Hawley, Pastor of Spiritual Growth – April 28, 2013

- **Lesson Aim:** To grow in our knowledge of God's perspective about our calling and the importance of saying, "No".
- **Prayer:** Ask the Holy Spirit to lead your personal study time and/or discussion.

**Icebreaker**: When it comes to getting things done, who in the group is a "list person?" For those that aren't how do you keep track of what needs to be done?

- On Sunday, Josh made a distinction between "being called" and "being driven." In your own words, share with the group the point that you think Josh was trying to make.
- 2. What are some of the characteristics of people for whom drivenness has taken over? Which ones do you identify or struggle with?
- 3. How does people-pleasing lead us to lives that are "driven" instead of "called?"
- 4. What is the difference between people-pleasing and putting others first? How do the following verses help answer this question? Colossians 3:23; 1 Corinthians 10:33-11:1; and Philippians 2:1-2

- 5. When is it hard to say "no?"
- 6. When it is hard to decide between "yes" or "no," what encouragement does Prov. 3:5,6 provide? What does practically applying this verse in your life look like?
- 7. Read **Colossians 3:23** again along with **Colossians 3:17**. How can being thankful help us to live a called life instead of a driven life?
- 8. As Christ followers we are God's "handiwork created in Christ Jesus to do good works" according to Ephesians 2:10 (NIV). Looking over Ephesians 2:4-9, what can we be thankful for that will make a difference in our "good works" (serving others)?
- 9. Share with your group something that has gotten your attention through Sunday's message or this lesson.

Close in prayer as the Lord leads you.
