

THE SOIL OF YOUR HEART

Luke 8:1-15

Jesus tells a parable that explains why people either trust, reject or don't last with Him. (verses 1-10)

- Jesus is traveling with His <u>disciples</u> and tells this parable to them "<u>while</u> a large crowd was gathering."
- He describes a <u>familiar</u>, <u>everyday</u> life example.
- When we <u>respond</u> to the light God gives us, we get <u>more</u>.
 When we <u>reject</u> what light we're given, we <u>lose</u> it.

Different heart (soil) conditions result in different responses to God. (verses 11-15)

- **Heart:** includes our intellect, emotions, conscience, desires and will. The heart is the seat of our <u>decision-making</u>; it is the <u>filter</u> for every action we take.
- A hard heart that has a closed mind toward God.

- A shallow, "what's in it for me?" attitude toward God.
- <u>Misplaced</u> priorities (worries, riches & pleasures) that crowd out God.
- An open & receptive heart toward God.

How can we cultivate an open & receptive heart?

- Respond to the light God gives us with obedience.
- <u>Trust</u> in God & <u>cling</u> to Him through the pressures and trials of life.
- Examine our <u>priorities</u> and make <u>space</u> for God.
- Stay <u>faithful</u> & <u>don't give</u> <u>up</u> as we "sow seed" (invest spiritually into the lives of others).

- o I will read my Bible 4 or more times a week for 4 weeks
- o I will ask for prayer from, or find, a LifeGroup this week
- o I will seek to pray at least 5 minutes a day this coming week

Lesson Aim: To grow in our understanding of why people respond to Jesus in different ways and in our ability to cultivate an open heart toward Him.

Prayer: Ask the Holy Spirit to lead your study time and/or discussion.

Icebreaker: Have you ever been responsible to help something (or someone) grow in any way? What was hard about it? What did you enjoy about it?

- 1. **READ Luke 8:1-8.** What are the different soil conditions that the seed falls on? Why did Jesus describe them?
- 2. **READ Luke 9-15.** How does the devil go about stealing God's messages from people today?
- 3. What things prevent people from putting down deep roots with God today?

- 4. What are some of the cares, riches and worries that tempt people from really growing as Christ-followers?
- 5. As followers of Christ, we're called to maintain receptive hearts to what God says in the Bible. However, there are times when we don't obey. Looking at your answers to questions 2-4, which of these do you struggle with the most?
- 6. Look over the notes from Pastor Josh's teaching under the section "How can we cultivate an open & receptive heart?" Which of these might help you the most right now as you consider your answer to question 5?
- 7. We have no control over the type of "soil" a person is, and only God can change the soil (heart) of a person. However, we can have positive influence for Christ in people's lives. In the following verses, what actions do you find that help us influence people?
 - 1 Peter 2:11-17:
 - Mark 2:15-17:
 - 1 Thessalonians 4:11-12:
 - 2 Timothy 2:24-26:
- 8. Is there anything that came up from this week's teaching or homework that you'd like prayer for?
