  - Revelation 21:1-8:

- 4. **READ Colossians 3:1-3.** What stands out to you in these verses?
- 5. What specifically do these verses teach us about the type of mindset or perspective we should live with?
- 6. How do you think living your life with an eternal perspective would affect the way you live each day?
- 7. Jesus died on the cross to pay for our sin and so that we could spend all eternity with Him. Since people will not go to heaven without Christ, a key part of our life mission is to reach others for Him.

Write down the names of 2 or 3 people who are in your "circles of life" (family; friends; co-workers/classmates; acquaintances) who are not connected to Christian community. Begin to pray for them and actively look for opportunities to invite them to church.

Close in prayer as the Holy Spirit leads you.
