## SPIRITUAL MYTH-BUSTING

**Lesson Aim:** To discuss spiritual myths about Jesus and our understanding of Him, and how to overcome these myths with biblical truth.

Prayer: Ask the Holy Spirit to lead your study time and/or discussion.

**Ice-breaker:** What is a myth or urban legend you once believed and later discovered to not be true?

- 1. **READ Luke 9:18-20.** Why do the crowds say that Jesus may be John the Baptist, Elijah or one of the prophets resurrected?
- 2. What answers do people give to the question of who Jesus is today?
- 3. Did you ever have a view of Jesus' identity that was different than it is today? How so?
- 4. Why is it important to have a correct view of who Jesus is? What types of differences does it make in our lives?
- 5. **READ** the following verses and write down what they tell us about Who Jesus is:
  - John 11:25-26:

- John 14:6-7:
- 2 Corinthians 4:4-6:
- Colossians 2:9-10:
- Hebrews 1:1-3:
- 6. **READ Luke 9:21-27**. Why did Jesus warn the disciples not to tell anyone His true identity? Was this a temporary or permanent command? Support your answer from the Bible.
- 7. How do you think the disciples would have responded to Jesus' words in verses 23-26? How do you respond?
- 8. Look over the "Four Dangerous Spiritual Myths" section in your notes from Pastor Chris's message. Which "myth" do you believe most often? Why?
- 9. What helps you focus on the truth in response to this myth?
- 10. What promises does Jesus make to people who will "deny themselves and take up their cross daily" to follow Him? How have you seen (in the lives of others) and/or experienced (in your own life) this to be true?

Close in prayer as the Holy Spirit leads you.
