1. **Read Luke 12:35-40.** Jesus is discussing the importance of staying ready and keeping alert. What are some things that you do or can do to stay ready and be alert for His return?
2. What are some things that distract you from these activities that would help to keep you alert and ready?
3. What does the phrase "Live each day fully" mean to you?

4. What is one thing that you can think of that you can spend some time on that will benefit the Kingdom and Jesus' return?
5. **READ Matthew 6:25-34.** Jesus is addressing the topic of worrying about what the future holds and how we will be provided for. Why do you think He focused so much detail on this topic?
6. In our present society, what are some things that people seem to worry the most about?
7. What in particular do you find yourself worrying about in the future?
8. Is there a situation either past or present that you worried quite a bit about, but it never came to pass or happened?
9. How can you keep yourself from worrying about the future so you can focus on the present and keeping the Kingdom ready?
